



THE IONA DAY NURSERY INFORMATION

The Iona Day Nursery, established in 1992, is part of the Iona School Association. Both the school and nursery are governed by the collaborative efforts of the parents, the College of Teachers and the School Council.

Our Nursery Manager, **Helen Fitzsimmons** manages the daily running of the nursery. All other nursery staff are qualified or working towards qualification.

The nursery itself is located approximately 5 minutes from the city centre. Sneinton is well signposted from the city, and Sneinton Dale is the main road through the suburb. There is a frequent and reliable bus service, (No 43, Nottingham City Transport) from King Street and/or Parliament Street, and there are bus stops close to the entrance to the school and nursery car park.

Both the nursery and school are situated behind the 'Bakersfield Community Centre'. The nursery is signposted from the car park and entry can be gained via the steps to the left of the car park. Access with pushchairs is made easier by following a route around the school buildings and through the playground.

For security purposes all doors to the nursery are kept locked at all times. Please ring the bell or knock on the window for assistance.

The Iona Day Nursery is not state funded. This has two main implications:-

- 1) we are unable to offer free childcare places
- 2) we are free to adopt a different approach to childcare.

We are a registered childcare facility and are Ofsted inspected. Copies of our most recent Ofsted report are available for your perusal in the nursery foyer.
