

Pupil Code of Conduct and School Rules Policy

(Revised August 2018)

Prepared with reference to the DfE publication "Behaviour and discipline in schools, Guidance for governing bodies July 2013"

Introduction

The Iona school relies on all its pupils following a strict code of conduct, these are known as the school rules. We ask that parents and guardians assist their children in maintaining these.

We hope that this will lead us to a happy, secure and safe school for all children, staff and visitors.

The School Rules

1. Wear appropriate clothing, footwear and avoid jewelry
2. Never swear or shout aggressively at others
3. Always ask permission to leave the classroom
4. Pupils should always walk within the school building as running can cause accidents.
5. Treat others fairly
6. Take responsibility for one's own behavior rather than trying to blame others
7. Be ready for the start of each lesson.
8. Always have the utmost respect for other people's property and for the school building itself.
9. Make sure everyone has a chance to do well in class, by putting your hand up and not shouting out answers.
10. Listen carefully to the teacher's instructions, so that they do not have to be repeated.
11. Always do the very best one can in the classroom and the playground, and complete homework on time.
12. Not bring sweets, sugary drinks, chewing/bubble gum or other confectionary into the school, and eat only at the proper times.
13. Take care of the school buildings, the outdoor areas and everyone who works in it, use litter bins and compost bins
14. Always think about how our actions will affect others.
15. Be courteous and polite to teachers, staff and to one another. Pupils are expected to address both staff and visitors in a respectful manner and to open doors for them when appropriate.
16. To not use mobile phones, gaming devices or any other such electronic devices during school hours (including breakfast and afterschool club)
17. To not swap or sell personal possessions (including swap cards) during school hours
18. To always stay within the school boundaries and within sight of a responsible adult
19. To report to a teacher or responsible adult if they are not collected at home time.
20. To always encourage a 'telling' environment
21. To never name call, bully or carry out hurtful behavior

22. Arrive at school punctually
23. Attend school regularly
24. Bring the correct articles they need for the day.
25. Report to a teacher or staff member if they are not collected at the end of the day
